India should withdraw from the 'quad alliance' immediately

The All India Peace and Solidarity Organisation (AIPSO) condemns the American Seventh Fleet warship's blatant intrusion into India's Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) waters off the coast of Lakshadweep in Indian territorial waters. We urge all the political parties in our country to protest this violation of Indian sovereign rights and the government of India to stand up to the US administration.

For the past many years, the famed independent foreign policy of our country is confined to the back-burner in the name of 'waking up to the strategic realities of a changed world'.
